1. How do we use cookies?

1. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that, if you agree to the cookie, we store on your browser or the hard drive of your device.
2. Our Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This information allows us to provide you with an enhanced experience when you use our Website and allows us to make improvements to the Website. We may also use this cookie information for Website administration and where we need to disclose cookie information about the Website for security purposes.
3. We use the following cookies:
 1. **Strictly necessary cookies.** Cookies that are required for the operation of the Website, for example cookies that enable you to use the Website shopping cart.
 2. **Statistics cookies.** Cookies that allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to the Website, and to see how our visitors use the Website. This helps us to improve the way the Website works.
 3. **Preferences and functionality cookies.** Cookies that allow us to recognise you when you return to the Website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, and remember your preferences.
 4. **Marketing cookies.** Cookies that record your visit to the Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests, and we may share this information with relevant third parties in relation to this purpose.
4. You can select if we can use the statistics, preferences and functionality and marketing cookies by checking the relevant boxes in the cookie preferences box on the Website. However please note that if you use your web browser settings to block all cookies (including strictly necessary cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of the Website.
5. We use Google Analytics to collect information about how visitors use our Website. We may use Google Analytics cookies to collect information about how users use our Website in order to improve our Website. Please note that Google Analytics does not track your internet activity after leaving our Website.
6. Social media cookies. Our Website may contain buttons and content from social media sites such as Instagram, Twitter or Facebook, to enable you to share content from our Website with your social media networks. If you use these features, these social media sites may use their own cookies. Information on how these are used can be found in the respective social media site's terms and conditions.
